Desirable: Library instruction or teaching experience; experience with electronic resources and applications such as online indexing systems, internet, an integrated library system, and web page development; ability to work with diverse clientele, including minorities and persons with disabilities; strong service commitment; excellent oral, written, and interpersonal communication skills; knowledge of current trends and issues in librarianship; willingness to serve as needed in a range of library assignments, which may include assignment to provide reference and instructional service to a specific subject discipline or program area such as communication studies, business, education, or lower division composition; may also include development of access or finding tools and/or processing of specialized or digitized materials; includes evening and weekend hours

Application Process: Applicants should forward a current resume and a letter of application specifying interest in full-time or part-time employment and, whenever possible, times available for assignments. The resume should include educational background, prior library experience (reference & instructional) and/or related professional experience and names and addresses of at least three professional references.
