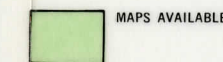


INDEX TO MAPS OF

SHEET SIZE AS INDICATED ON INDIVIDUAL SHEETS

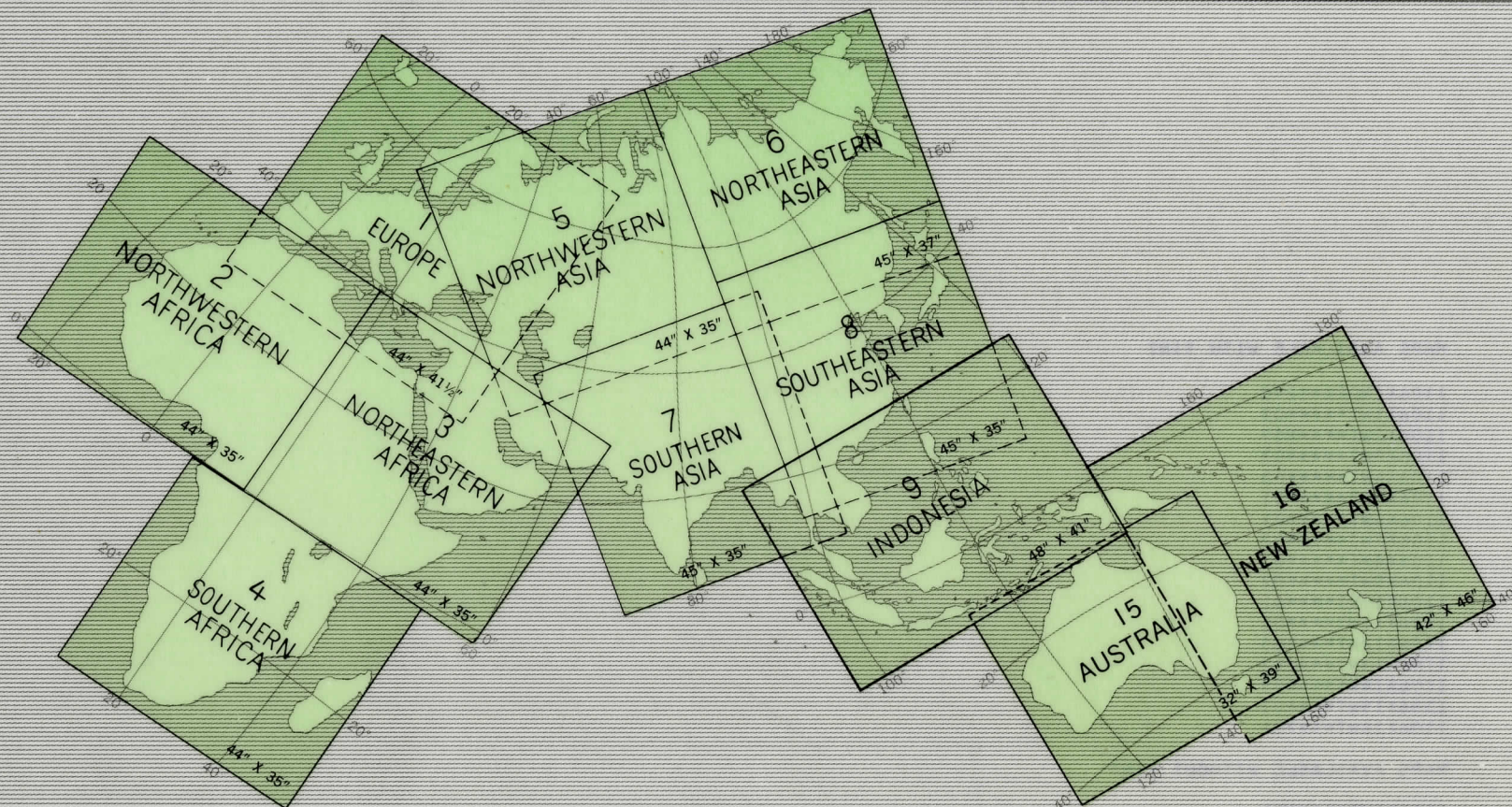
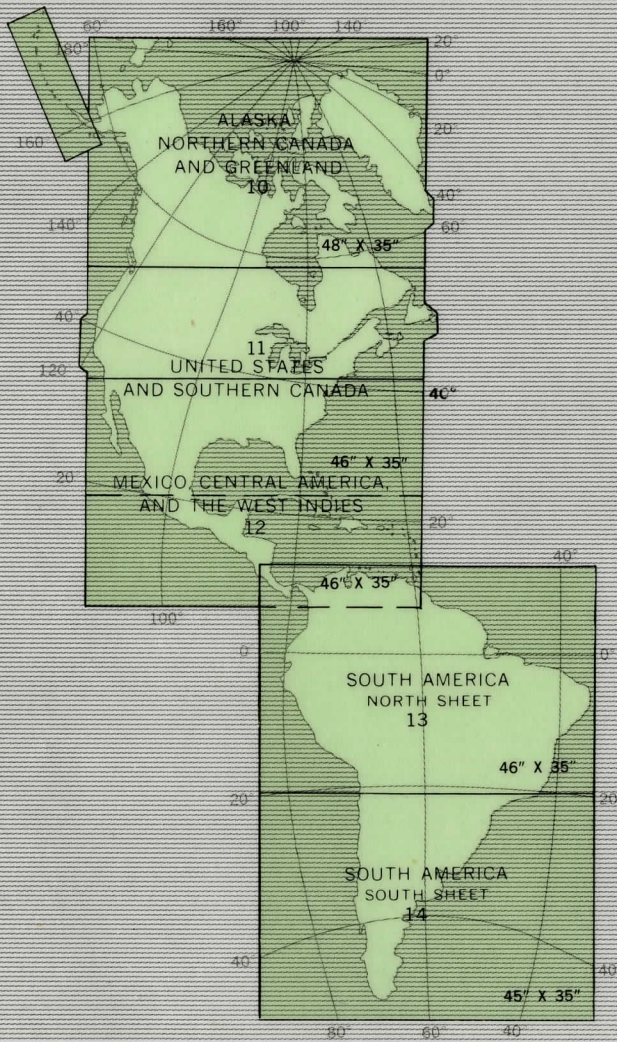
ORDER BY STOCK
NUMBER

Stock numbers for available maps are listed on reverse of this index.

THE STOCK NUMBER is a 15-character, alphanumeric identification, constituted as follows:

1. The series number (5 characters). When the series number is less than 5 characters, an X is entered as the 5th character.
2. The sheet number, or name (8 characters).
 - a. Roman numerals are converted to Arabic.
 - b. If map identification is by name instead of number, those letters beyond 8 are omitted.
 - c. If sheet number or name is less than 8 characters, an asterisk is entered in each unused space.
3. The edition number (2 characters). An edition number less than 10 is entered as the 15th character, preceded by a zero in the 14th space.

DELINEATION OF INTERNATIONAL BOUNDARIES

1. All five sheets which are available for the Western Hemisphere are on one projection and can be fitted together as a unit if so desired.
2. All eleven sheets which are available for Europe, Africa and Asia are also on one projection and can be fitted together as a unit if so desired.

SERIES DESCRIPTION

TYPE: Topographic: polychrome.

FORMAT: Sheet format varies: projection varies for Western and Eastern Hemisphere but sheets designed to join adjacent sheets.

SYMBOLS: American Geographical Society.
