ORDER BY STOCK NUMBER

Stock numbers for available maps are listed on reverse of this index.

THE STOCK NUMBER is a 15-character, alphanumeric identification, constituted as follows:

1. The series number (5 characters). When the series number is less than 5 characters, an X is entered as the 5th character.
2. The sheet number, or name (8 characters).
 - a. Roman numerals are converted to Arabic.
 - b. If map identification is by name instead of number, those letters beyond 8 are omitted.
 - c. If sheet number or name is less than 8 characters, an asterisk is entered in each unused space.
3. The edition number (2 characters). An edition number less than 10 is entered as the 15th character, preceded by a zero in the 14th space.

SERIES DESCRIPTION

TYPE: Topographic; 4 colors.
FORMAT: 1° N-S x 2° E-W; 10,000 meter British grid.
SOURCE: Land and Survey Department, Nigeria.
CHARACTERISTICS: International, colonial and provincial boundaries delineated; relief expressed in form lines at 200 foot intervals to 1000 feet, and 500 foot intervals above; heights in feet; populated places symbolized with large towns, towns and villages indicated by type size; roads classified by surface and weatherability; railroads shown as single or double track; extensive drainage pattern.
