REQUISITION MAPS BY STOCK NUMBER

Stock numbers are constructed as follows:
 A. The first 5 characters consist of the map series number. When the series number is less than 5 characters, the 5th character is the letter X.
 B. The remaining characters of the stock number are the map sheet number (see SHEET NUMBERING SCHEME).
 Exceptions: (1) The words "ALL SHEETS" are used in lieu of sheet number if stock number is intended to identify all available sheets of map series. (2) The word "INDEX" is used in lieu of sheet number to identify the series index.

C. Examples: (SERIES K502)

 CHARACTERISTICS: International USSR, II and nomis boundaries delineated; relief indicated by contours at 100 meter intervals with supplemental contours at 50 meter intervals, augmented by shaded relief; populated places shown by block pattern with tint; less populated places symbolized; roads classified by surface, width and weatherability; railroads classified by gauge and number of tracks; vegetation symbolized; glossary.
