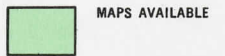


INDEX TO MAPS OF

**ORDER BY STOCK NUMBER**

Stock numbers for available maps are listed on reverse of this index.

THE STOCK NUMBER is a 15-character, alphanumeric identification, constituted as follows:

1. The series number (5 characters). When the series number is less than 5 characters, an X is entered as the 5th character.
2. The sheet number, or name (8 characters).
  - a. Roman numerals are converted to Arabic.
  - b. If map identification is by name instead of number, those letters beyond 8 are omitted.
  - c. If sheet number or name is less than 8 characters, an asterisk is entered in each unused space.
3. The edition number (2 characters). An edition number less than 10 is entered as the 15th character, preceded by a zero in the 14th space.

**SERIES DESCRIPTION**

**TYPE:** Topographic; multicolor.  
**FORMAT:** Transverse Mercator Projection; 1° N-S x 1°30' E-W south of 40° and 1° N-S x 2° E-W north of 40°; 10,000 meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid.  
**SYMBOLS:** Standard.  
**SOURCE:** Compiled from 1:50,000 AMS and Japanese Imperial Land Survey maps, with photo revisions where necessary.  
**CHARACTERISTICS:** International and To boundaries designated; cities and towns classified by importance according to population; diagrammatic plans showing main routes through major cities appear as back-ups; roads classified by surface and width; railroads shown as single or double track and by gauge; relief depicted by contours at 100 meter intervals with supplementary contours at 50 meters; spot heights in meters; land and seaplane airports symbolized; foreshore and offshore features shown; woodland tint; glossary.
