



SERIES DESCRIPTION

TYPE: Topographic; colored, gridded (10,000 yard-World Polyconic).

FORMAT: Standard A.M.S. for 1:250,000, 1° x 1° based on Greenwich.

SOURCES: 1:50,000 and 1:200,000 maps of the Japanese Imperial Land Survey, 1910-1939, Japanese Hydrographic charts, 1925-35; U. S. Hydrographic charts, 1914-43.

COMPILATION PROCEDURE: Compilations were prepared, using the Japanese sources as bases, which were adjusted to conform to a datum correction averaging 10.4 seconds. Pertinent information was incorporated from the H. O. charts. The conventional signs are standard A.M.S.

CHARACTERISTICS: Contours are shown at 100 meter intervals; where contour information is lacking, prominences are indicated by hachures. Japanese place names are transliteration according to the Modified Hepburn (Romaji) System. A glossary is included translating all Japanese generics employed on the sheets.

COMMUNICATIONS: Roads and railroads are classified according to original sources and Intelligence Reports. Air data, according to Intelligence Reports.

RELIABILITY: Information pertaining to communications is questionable since no 1944 data is available. Topography, control and population breakdown are fairly dependable.
