SERIES DESCRIPTION

TYPE: Topographic; 2 colors; (gridded-World Polyconic).

FORMAT: 10'x15'. Corner values of meridians display an average correction of 10.4 seconds.

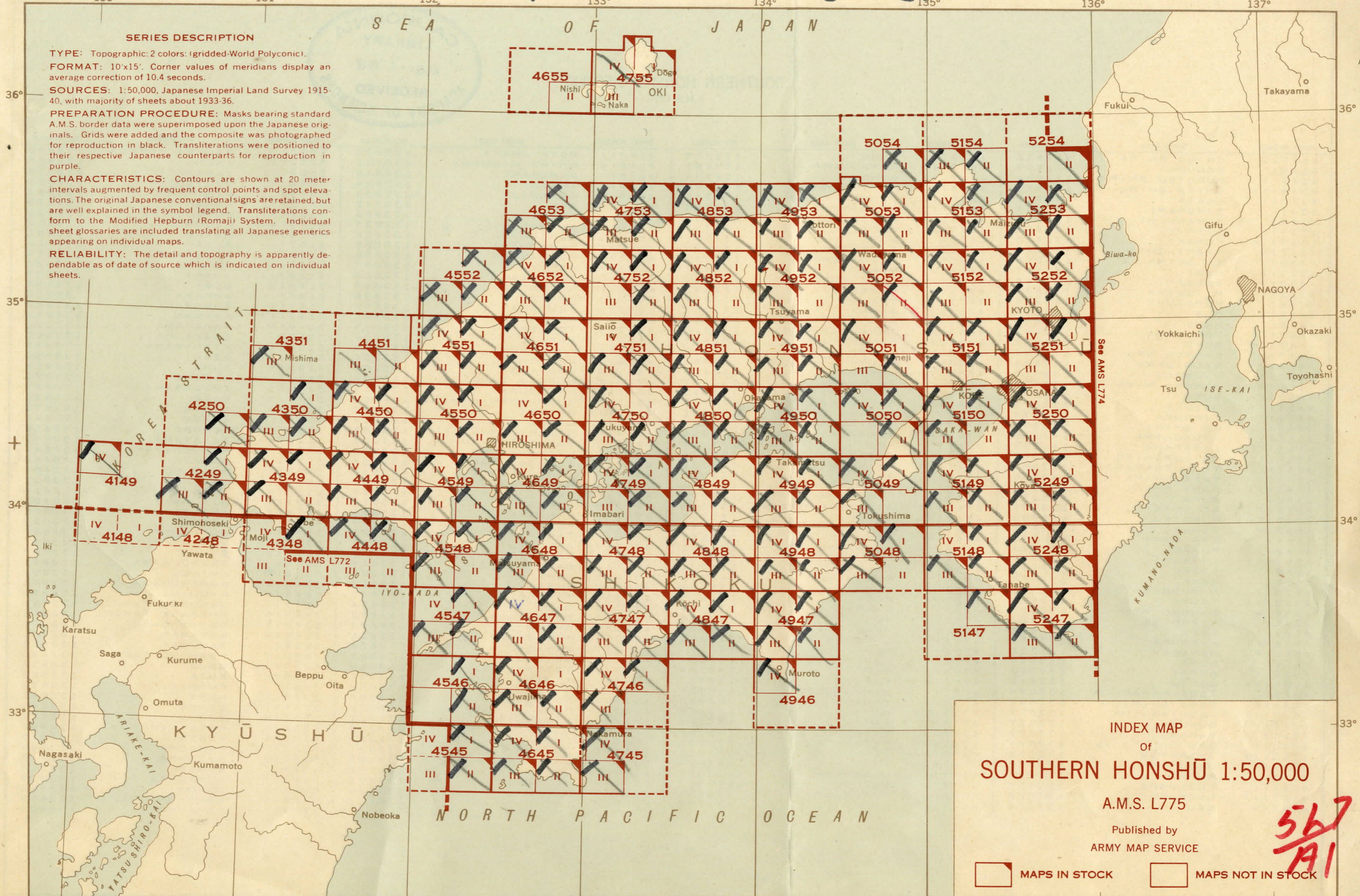
SOURCES: 1:50,000, Japanese Imperial Land Survey 1915-40, with majority of sheets about 1933-36.

PREPARATION PROCEDURE: Masks bearing standard A.M.S. border data were superimposed upon the Japanese originals. Grids were added and the composite was photographed for reproduction in black. Transliterations were positioned to their respective Japanese counterparts for reproduction in purple.

CHARACTERISTICS: Contours are shown at 20 meter intervals augmented by frequent control points and spot elevations. The original Japanese conventional signs are retained, but are well explained in the symbol legend. Transliterations conform to the Modified Hepburn (Romaji) System. Individual sheet glossaries are included translating all Japanese generics appearing on individual maps.

RELIABILITY: The detail and topography is apparently dependable as of date of source which is indicated on individual sheets.
