


INDEX TO MAPS OF

**REQUISITION MAPS  
BY STOCK NUMBER**

Stock numbers are constructed as follows:

A. The first 5 characters consist of the map series number. When the series number is less than 5 characters, the 5th character is the letter X.

B. The remaining characters of the stock number are the map sheet number.

Exceptions: (1) The words "ALL SHEETS" are used in lieu of sheet number if stock number is intended to identify all available sheets of map series. (2) The word "INDEX" is used in lieu of sheet number to identify the series index.

C. Examples: (SERIES M501)

**SERIES DESCRIPTION**

TYPE: Topographic; 6 to 8 colors  
 FORMAT: Sheet size: South of 40°-1°N-S x 1°30' E-W, North of 40°-1°N-S x 2° E-W. Transverse Mercator Projection; 10,000 meter UTM grid, based on International Spheroid.  
 SYMBOLS: AMS and German  
 SOURCES: Compiled by AMS and IFAG (coverage of Germany) from original and AMS maps at various scales and aerial photography as available.  
 CHARACTERISTICS: International boundaries, post-war limits of national administration, and primary administrative boundaries of countries concerned delineated; relief indicated by contours at 10, 20, 50, or 100 meters as suited to terrain; heights in meters, populated places shown outlined to shape (with tint) or symbol and classified according to population; roads classified by surface and weatherability; railroads classified according to gauge and number of tracks; vegetation symbolized; hydrographic data including depth curves and obstructions delineated; bilingual and trilingual marginal data; glossary and coverage diagrams shown.
