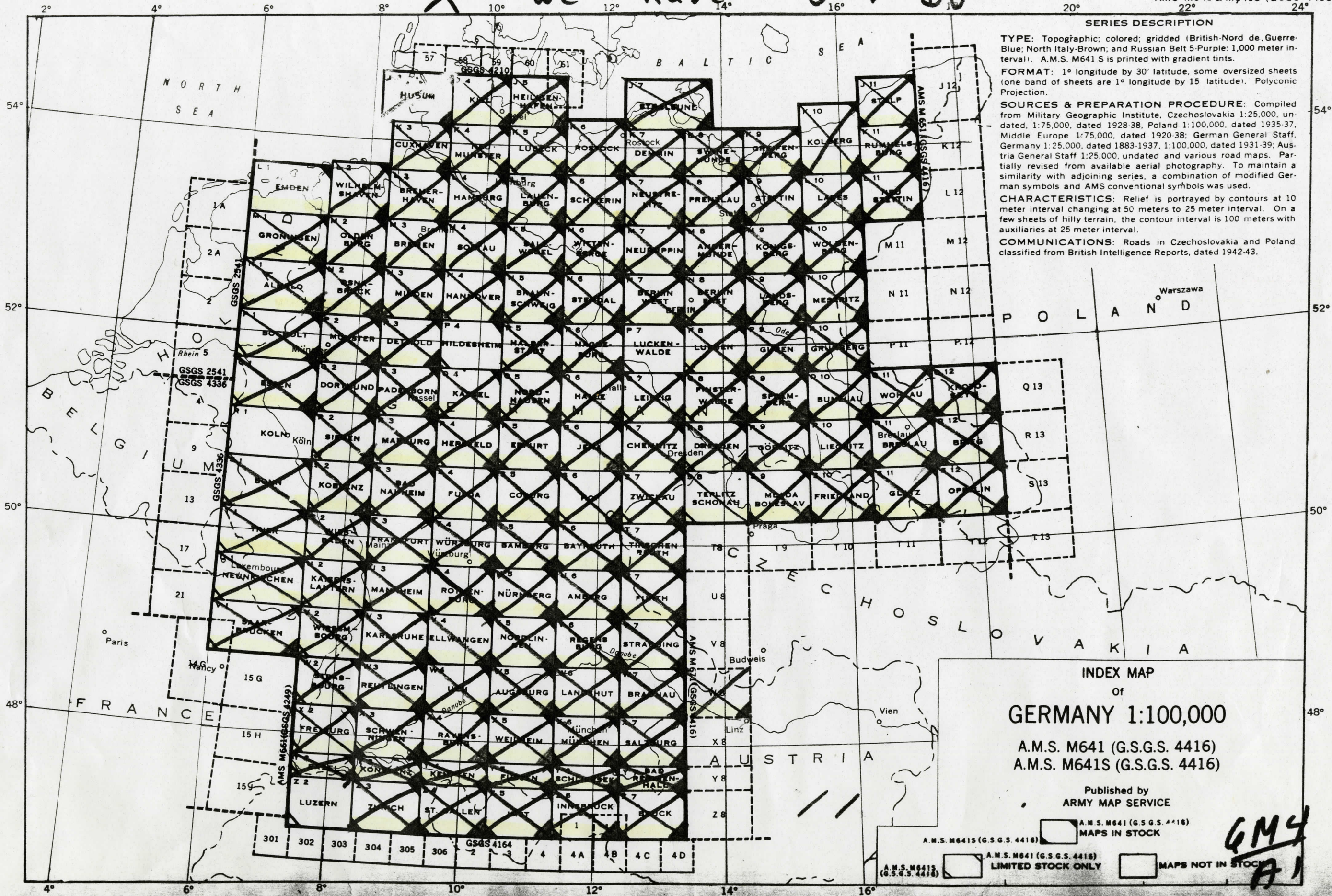

SERIES DESCRIPTION

TYPE: Topographic; colored; gridded (British-Nord de.Guerre-Blue; North Italy-Brown; and Russian Belt 5-Purple: 1,000 meter interval). A.M.S. M641 S is printed with gradient tints.

FORMAT: 1° longitude by 30' latitude, some oversized sheets (one band of sheets are 1° longitude by 15 latitude). Polyconic Projection.

SOURCES & PREPARATION PROCEDURE: Compiled from Military Geographic Institute, Czechoslovakia 1:25,000, undated, 1:75,000, dated 1928-38, Poland 1:100,000, dated 1935-37, Middle Europe 1:75,000, dated 1920-38; German General Staff, Germany 1:25,000, dated 1883-1937, 1:100,000, dated 1931-39; Austria General Staff 1:25,000, undated and various road maps. Partially revised from available aerial photography. To maintain a similarity with adjoining series, a combination of modified German symbols and AMS conventional symbols was used.

CHARACTERISTICS: Relief is portrayed by contours at 10 meter interval changing at 50 meters to 25 meter interval. On a few sheets of hilly terrain, the contour interval is 100 meters with auxiliaries at 25 meter interval.

COMMUNICATIONS: Roads in Czechoslovakia and Poland classified from British Intelligence Reports, dated 1942-43.
