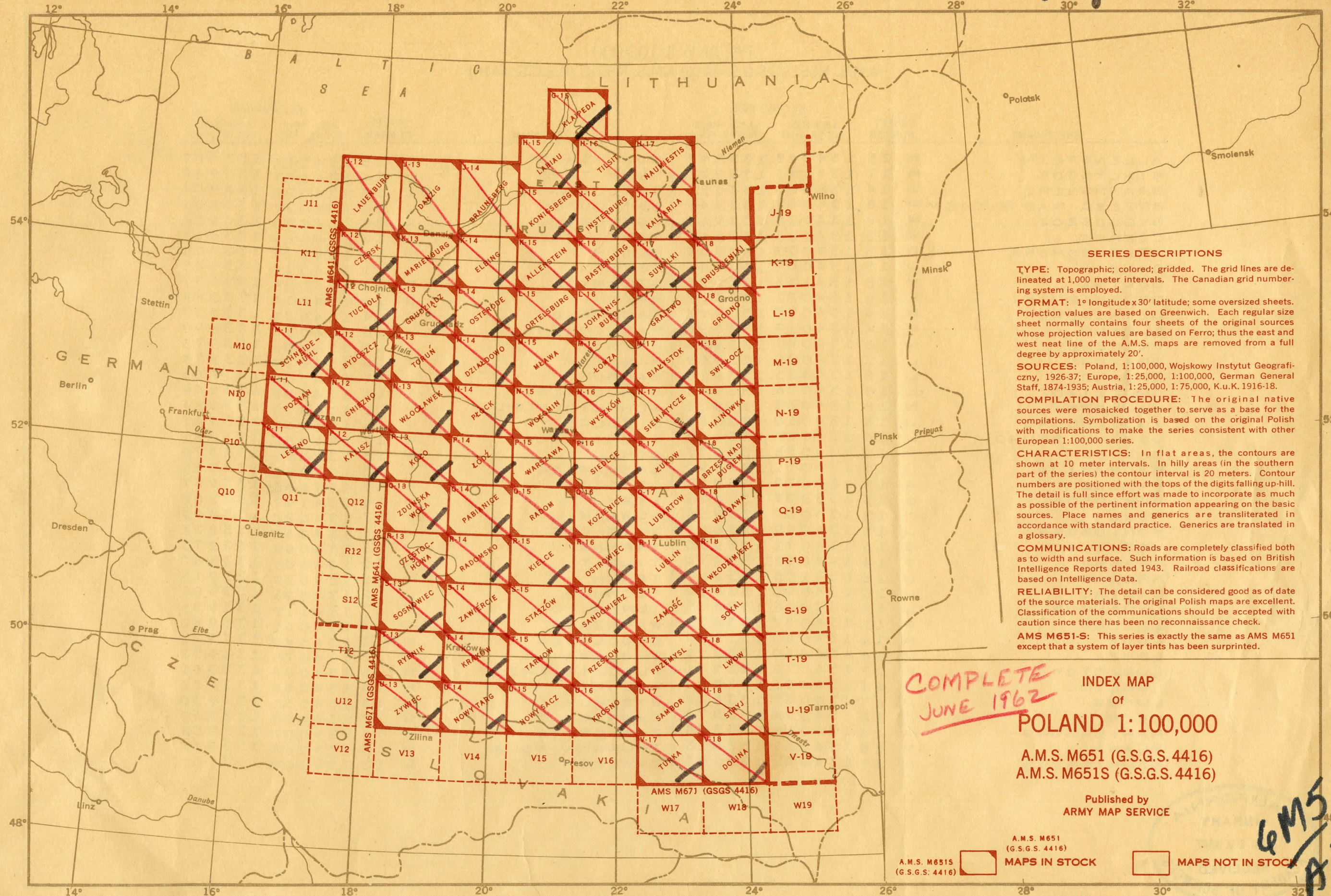

AMS M651 & M651S (G.S.G.S. 4416)



SERIES DESCRIPTIONS

TYPE: Topographic; colored; gridded. The grid lines are delineated at 1,000 meter intervals. The Canadian grid numbering system is employed.

FORMAT: 1° longitude x 30' latitude; some oversized sheets. Projection values are based on Greenwich. Each regular size sheet normally contains four sheets of the original sources whose projection values are based on Ferro; thus the east and west neat line of the A.M.S. maps are removed from a full degree by approximately 20'.

SOURCES: Poland, 1:100,000, Wojskowy Instytut Geograficzny, 1926-37; Europe, 1:25,000, 1:100,000, German General Staff, 1874-1935; Austria, 1:25,000, 1:75,000, K.u.K. 1916-18.

COMPILATION PROCEDURE: The original native sources were mosaicked together to serve as a base for the compilations. Symbolization is based on the original Polish with modifications to make the series consistent with other European 1:100,000 series.

CHARACTERISTICS: In flat areas, the contours are shown at 10 meter intervals. In hilly areas (in the southern part of the series) the contour interval is 20 meters. Contour numbers are positioned with the tops of the digits falling up-hill. The detail is full since effort was made to incorporate as much as possible of the pertinent information appearing on the basic sources. Place names and generics are transliterated in accordance with standard practice. Generics are translated in a glossary.

COMMUNICATIONS: Roads are completely classified both as to width and surface. Such information is based on British Intelligence Reports dated 1943. Railroad classifications are based on Intelligence Data.

RELIABILITY: The detail can be considered good as of date of the source materials. The original Polish maps are excellent. Classification of the communications should be accepted with caution since there has been no reconnaissance check.

AMS M651-S: This series is exactly the same as AMS M651 except that a system of layer tints has been surprinted.
