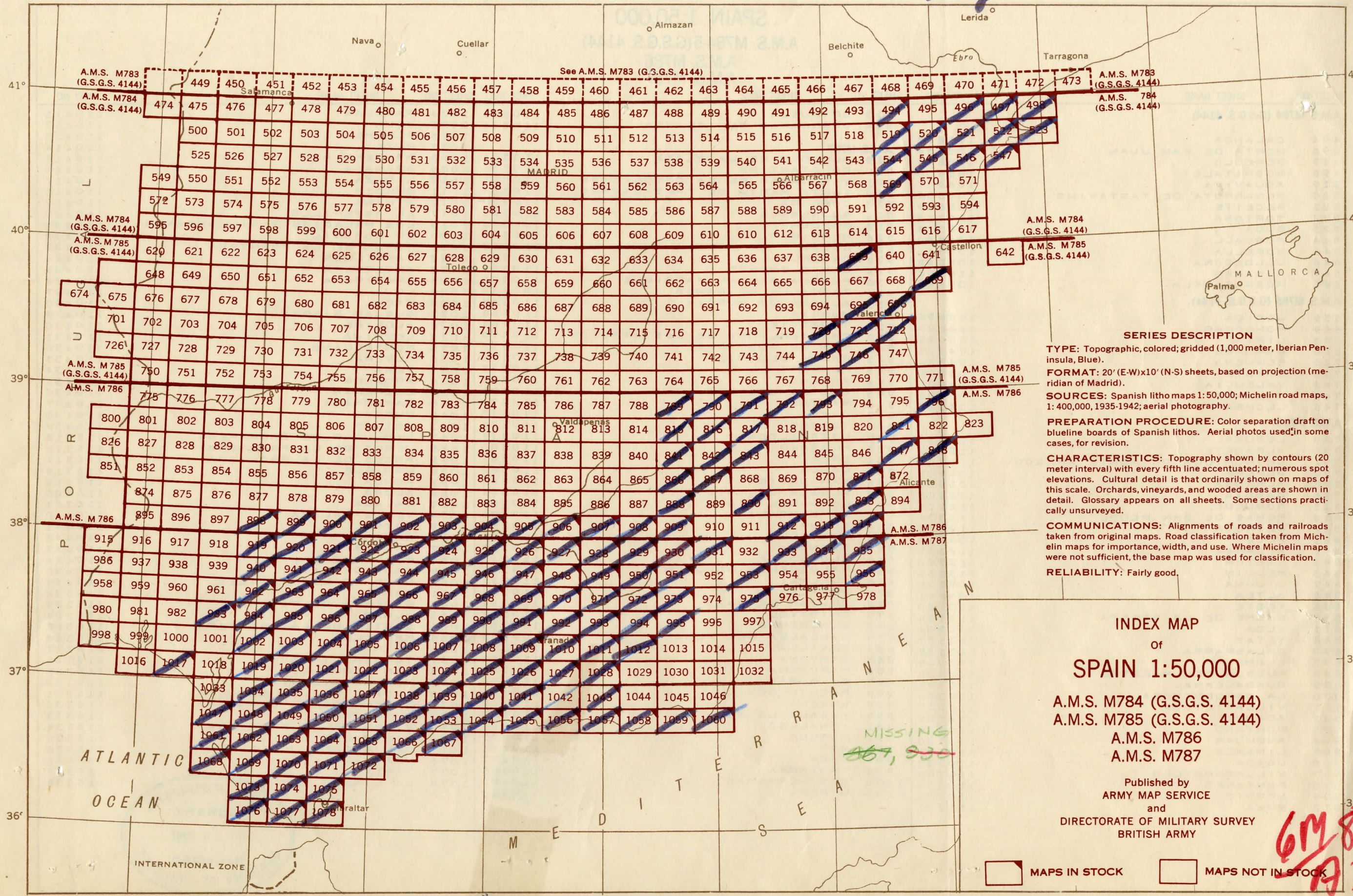

SERIES DESCRIPTION

TYPE: Topographic, colored; gridded (1,000 meter, Iberian Peninsula, Blue).

FORMAT: 20' (E-W)x10' (N-S) sheets, based on projection (meridian of Madrid).

SOURCES: Spanish litho maps 1:50,000; Michelin road maps, 1:400,000, 1935-1942; aerial photography.

PREPARATION PROCEDURE: Color separation draft on blue-line boards of Spanish lithos. Aerial photos used in some cases, for revision.

CHARACTERISTICS: Topography shown by contours (20 meter interval) with every fifth line accentuated; numerous spot elevations. Cultural detail is that ordinarily shown on maps of this scale. Orchards, vineyards, and wooded areas are shown in detail. Glossary appears on all sheets. Some sections practically unsurveyed.

COMMUNICATIONS: Alignments of roads and railroads taken from original maps. Road classification taken from Michelin maps for importance, width, and use. Where Michelin maps were not sufficient, the base map was used for classification.

RELIABILITY: Fairly good.
