ORDER BY STOCK NUMBER

Stock numbers for available maps are listed on reverse of this index.

THE STOCK NUMBER is a 15-character, alphanumeric identification, constituted as follows:

1. The series number (5 characters). When the series number is less than 5 characters, an X is entered as the 5th character.
2. The sheet number, or name (8 characters).
 - a. Roman numerals are converted to Arabic.
 - b. If map identification is by name instead of number, those letters beyond 8 are omitted.
 - c. If sheet number or name is less than 8 characters, an asterisk is entered in each unused space.
3. The edition number (2 characters). An edition number less than 10 is entered as the 15th character, preceded by a zero in the 14th space.

SERIES DESCRIPTION

TYPE: Topographic, Polychrome.
 FORMAT: Sheet size 1° N-S x 1°30' E-W; Transverse Mercator Projection; UTM Grid; corner graticule coordinates with marginal graticule ticks at 15' intervals; sheets compiled by AMS also carry secondary grid ticks of NEI Equatorial Zone British Metric or U. S. Yard Grid or 10,000 Meter Southern New Guinea Zone, as the zone may require.
 SYMBOLS: Army Map Service or Royal Australian Survey Corps.
 SOURCE: Prepared by Army Map Service or the Royal Australian Survey Corps from aerial photography and existing charts and maps.
 CHARACTERISTICS: International, major, and first class administrative boundaries delineated; relief indicated by contours, approximate contours, and form lines at various meter intervals and by hachures; spot heights in meters; populated places symbolized and classified according to importance; roads classified by surface, width and weather limitations; vegetation symbolized; foreshore and offshore detail; reliability and location diagrams; glossary.
