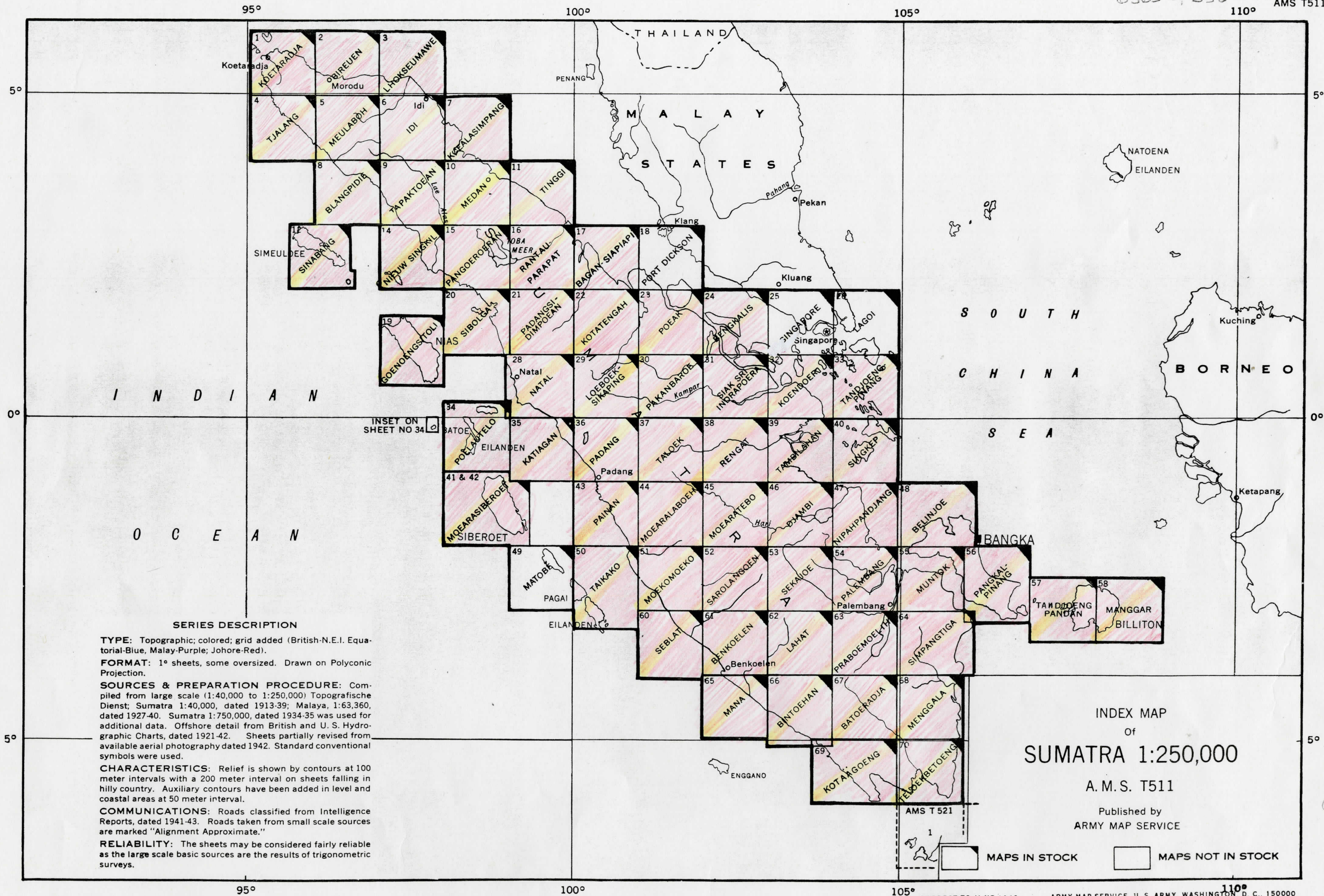

SERIES DESCRIPTION

TYPE: Topographic; colored; grid added (British-N.E.I. Equatorial-Blue, Malay-Purple; Johore-Red).

FORMAT: 1° sheets, some oversized. Drawn on Polyconic Projection.

SOURCES & PREPARATION PROCEDURE: Compiled from large scale (1:40,000 to 1:250,000) Topografische Dienst: Sumatra 1:40,000, dated 1913-39; Malaya, 1:63,360, dated 1927-40. Sumatra 1:750,000, dated 1934-35 was used for additional data. Offshore detail from British and U. S. Hydrographic Charts, dated 1921-42. Sheets partially revised from available aerial photography dated 1942. Standard conventional symbols were used.

CHARACTERISTICS: Relief is shown by contours at 100 meter intervals with a 200 meter interval on sheets falling in hilly country. Auxiliary contours have been added in level and coastal areas at 50 meter interval.

COMMUNICATIONS: Roads classified from Intelligence Reports, dated 1941-43. Roads taken from small scale sources are marked "Alignment Approximate."

RELIABILITY: The sheets may be considered fairly reliable as the large scale basic sources are the results of trigonometric surveys.
