



SERIES DESCRIPTION

TYPE: Topographic, colored, gridded (10,000 meter N.E.I. Equatorial Zone--blue; 10,000 meter N.E.I. Southern Zone--red; 10,000 yard World Polyconic, Band III S, Zone F--purple).

FORMAT: 1° x 1° with a few sheets 10' oversize latitudinally. Polyconic projection based on Greenwich Meridian.

SOURCES: Based on the standard Dutch 1:50,000 topographic maps of Java and Bali dated 1915 to 1942, augmented and revised from the Dutch 1:250,000 series (1925-1940). Revisions to shore and offshore detail were made from Netherlands Hydrographic Charts.

PREPARATION PROCEDURE: Compilation of source materials. Blue-line boards used for drafting color separation.

CHARACTERISTICS: Elevation shown by 100 meter contour intervals with auxiliary contours at 50 meters where needed. Spot heights are indicated. Location and extent of salt pans, rice fields, marshes, mud and tidal flats shown. Towns of duplicate names are numbered in accordance with arbitrary Dutch system. Glossary appears on each sheet. Extent of dangerous coast line given.

COMMUNICATIONS: Roads are classified as to width and surface, utilizing Intelligence Reports and the original Dutch large scale maps. In some areas, where complete information was lacking, the alignment of roads is approximate. Railroads are classified as to gauge and number of tracks. Telephone and telegraph lines, shipping and aeronautical aids are shown.

RELIABILITY: Very good.
