



SERIES DESCRIPTION

TYPE: Topographic; colored; gridded (10,000 m. British-N. E. I. Equatorial-Blue).

FORMAT: 20' sheets, some oversized. Meridians based on Batavia.

SOURCES: (1) Dutch originals, Topografische Dienst, 1:100,000, dated 1925-24.

(2) Dutch originals, 1:300,000 Topografische Dienst, dated 1918; 1:500,000 Topografische Dienst, dated 1933; Netherlands Hydrographic Charts, dated 1922-29; and U. S. Hydrographic Charts, dated 1942. Air data and roads from Intelligence Reports.

PREPARATION PROCEDURE: (1) Color separation draft of Dutch originals using modified Dutch symbols. Grid added.

(2) Compiled from Dutch sources using modified Dutch symbols. Grid added.

CHARACTERISTICS: Relief generally shown by contours at 50 meter intervals with every fifth contour accentuated; auxiliary contours have been added in level areas, per the Dutch originals. Some areas are shown with form lines. Unsurveyed areas exist on some sheets.

RELIABILITY: The basic sources are made from rapid-sketch reconnaissance surveys; consequently, the A.M.S. maps should be used with caution.
