

SERIES DESCRIPTION

TYPE: Quarter inch Survey of India Series; topographic; set includes monochromatic and colored sheets.

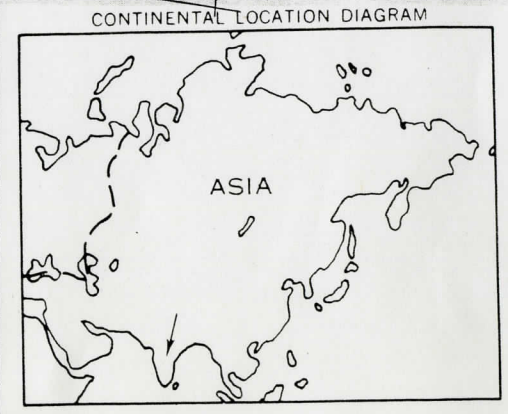
FORMAT: 1° sheets with variations in certain coastal areas to include land masses. British grid system at 10,000 yard intervals used.

SYMBOLS: Standard Survey of India.

SOURCES: Compiled under the direction of the Surveyor General of India from various and numerous sources including cadastral surveys dating back to late 19th century to recent date also late reconnaissance survey and occasionally, air surveys.

CHARACTERISTICS: Boundaries delineated include international (demarcated and undemarcated), provincial, district and lesser subdivisions; cities classified according to extent of built up area by appropriate building symbols; topography shown by either 500 foot or 250 foot intervals depending upon terrain; spot heights, bench marks and other geodetic measurements further elaborate relief system; roads and railroads classified in great detail; natural and cultural features extensive and numerous.
