



SERIES DESCRIPTION

TYPE: Topographic; contours or form lines shown in brown, all other features printed in black.

FORMAT: 1 minute sheets; numbering system based on the International Map of the World numbering system; military grid at 1000 yard intervals shown.

SYMBOLS: Modified standard.

SOURCES: Compiled from medium scale maps; much of the area surveyed between the years 1879 and 1929; supplemented with intelligence information.

CHARACTERISTICS: International, provincial and district boundaries portrayed; cities and communications classified; relief shown by either contours at 250 foot intervals or form lines; elevations shown by trigonometrical stations, spot heights or bench marks; drainage pattern shown.

RELIABILITY: Good in more populated areas to fair in sparsely settled areas.
