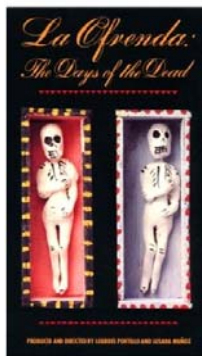

Moderated by Prof. Yreina Cervantes and Prof. Lara Medina, Chicana/o Studies.



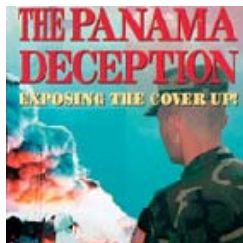
