Check for Full Text Using **Find Text**

If the article isn't available full text in the database you are searching, click the **GFind Text** button to see if we have access to the full text through another database or in print. A new page opens that will have one or more of the following links:

- Full text available via [database name]: Click to access the full-text online. If the link takes you to a publication-level page, you can navigate to the article by first choosing the correct year, then the correct month or volume number, then the issue, and then selecting the article from the displayed table of contents.
- We have this. Check availability in http://library.csun.edu/xerxes/databases/subject/health/orthridge Catalog: We have the article in print. Click to view the catalog record for the journal or magazine. You'll need to note the call number and then go to the fourth floor to get the article.
 - Request document via Interlibrary Loan: We do not have the article online or in print. You can request the article via interlibrary loan (takes approximately ten working days).

Learn how to sign up and use
 Endnote Web. You can import
 bibliographic records from a variety
 of resources to create your own
 personal database of articles, books,
 websites. Use EndNote Web to

collect, manage, and create a bibliography or works cited list from your citations.

Registration is free while you are a student. First time, to sign up for your EndNoteWeb account, you can connect directly to

http://library.csun.edu/restricted/endnote.scr

. In addition to asking Marcia Henry and other librarians for help, Endnote Web will also answer your questions about installing the Cite While you Write plugin for Microsoft Word on your own computer. If you install Cite While You Write plugin on your own computer in your MicroSoft Word, be sure to set Preferences so it goes to the url:


