 Declares the intent of the Legislature to enact legislation reflecting specified final recommendations of the Speaker of the Assembly's Commission on Regionalism

AB 857 - WIGGINS - STATE VISION/LOCAL PLANNING

- Two year bill but to be heard in conference committee this fall along with SB 741 –
 CCAPA is the sponsor
- A result of the CCAPA State Plan Task Force Report, this bill will be amended to include a
 State Vision or State Planning Principles and a requirement that state agencies tie the
 State Planning Principles to their own policies and funding decisions and work together
 to eliminate inconsistent state policies (Note: b 471 (Sher) is the vehicle for funding
 criteria.)
- It will also include, as a preamble to the general plan law, a requirement that local governments must incorporate the State Planning Principles in preparing local general plans, adapting the State Planning Principles to local conditions

AB 901 - DAUCHER - WATER SUPPLY PLANNING AND WATER QUALITY

- Signed by Governor, Chapter 644 CCAPA SUPPORTS
- Requires an urban water management plan to include information, to the extent
 practicable, relating to the quality of existing sources of water available to an urban
 water supplier over given time periods, and the manner in which water quality affects
 water management strategies and supply reliability
- Requires a plan to describe efforts to supplement a water source that may not be available at a consistent level of use, to the extent practicable

AB 924 - WAYNE - COOPERATIVE GENERAL PLANS

- Two-Year Bill CCAPA SUPPORTS
- Declares the intent of the Legislature to facilitate cooperative planning through incentives and rational growth principles
- One of three bills to be used as vehicle for outcome of infill housing working group, of which CCAPA is a member

AB 1044 - MIGDEN - INCREASE IN CA HOUSING FINANCE AGENCY REVENUE BOND AUTHORITY

- Signed by Governor, Chapter 202 CCAPA SUPPORTS
- Increases the total amount of tax-exempt revenue bonds that the California Housing Finance Agency may issue by \$2.2 billion, increasing the total amount authorized to \$11.15 billion
